

# 3 WAYS WE NEED YOU TO SHOW UP AND RESIST FASCISM:

## 1) COMMUNITY PATROL:

Dedicate 1+ hour per week to patrolling our communities. Use the "protect your neighbor" flyer (next page) to help you identify ICE vehicles and activity. If ICE is spotted, call the PIRC hotline: 1-888-622-1510

## 2) COME TO THE FEDERAL BUILDING PROTESTS: 211 E 7th Avenue, Eugene, OR

Any amount of time is helpful - take a lunch break once a week, or more if you can!

# CALL TO ACTION: PATROL YOUR COMMUNITY FOR I.C.E.

## ANYONE CAN PATROL! HOW?

This flyer tells you what you need to know to spot ICE your communities. Keep this flyer, or an image of this flyer, with you at all times. Dedicate even as little as 30 minutes a week-whatever your schedule allows-to drive around the community and patrol for ICE. Keep an eye out on your way to work, while running errands, while biking to the park, etc. Bring a buddy. Keep a safe distance. Do not do anything that goes beyond your comfort level.

## HOW TO SPOT I.C.E. IN YOUR NEIGHBORHOOD

### #1. Are they local law enforcement?

#### What to look for:

Yellow license plate that starts with "E"; Vehicle + uniform are marked with Lane County Sheriff's Office (LCSO), Eugene PD (EPD) or Springfield PD (SPD); Gear is on the front passenger seat; Front windows are untinted; Have a shiny badge and/or chest and shoulder badge patches; Unmasked. If you ask them to identify themselves they will likely tell you what dept they are from.

**If you answer yes to several of these questions, it's likely local law enforcement, not ICE.**

**Do not report to PIRC hotline.**

### #2. Are they federal agents/I.C.E.?

#### What to look for:

Marked with ERO, HSI, CBP, DHS, FPS (these are all federal agencies that assist with ICE kidnappings); Unmarked vehicle; All windows are heavily tinted; Green or black armored vehicle with federal or missing plates; Officers are traveling in packs; Wearing patterned gators and generic "police" vest; Uniforms are mismatched and missing star/shield badges; Heavily armed with tactical gear. And when you ask them to identify themselves, they ignore you.

**If you answer yes to several of these questions, report the sighting to PIRC hotline.**

## HOW TO REPORT ICE SIGHTINGS: S.A.L.U.T.E.

*Once you've identified a potential sighting, report it to the Portland Immigrants Rights Coalition (PIRC) using the S.A.L.U.T.E. guidelines for effective reporting:*

- **Size/Strength:** How many agents are present?
- **Actions/Activities:** What did you see them doing?
- **Location and Direction:** Where are they and where are they headed?
- **Uniform/Clothes:** What are they wearing? Describe as much as possible. Uniform? Plain clothes? Identifying logos, etc.
- **Time:** What time did the event occur?
- **Equipment and Weapons:** What are you able to see?
